Classes Offered

Two-Day Multi-Age (3 & 4 year olds)

Tuesday & Thursday

Must be three by September 30, 2009 & toilet trained.

Enrollment: 12 children with one teacher and one parent helper

9:00 a.m.-11:15 a.m.

Tuition: \$735.00 per year (\$245.00 x three payments)

9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m.

Tuition: \$1194.00 per year (\$398.00 x three payments)

Three-Day Multi-Age (3 & 4 year olds)

Monday, Wednesday, & Friday

Must be three by September 30, 2009 & toilet trained.

Enrollment: 12 children with one teacher and one parent helper

9:00 a.m.-11:15 a.m.

Tuition: \$1002.00 per year (\$334.00 x three payments)

9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m.

Tuition: \$1752.00 per year (\$584.00 x three payments)

Four-Day Pre-Kindergarten

Monday-Thursday

Must be four by September 30, 2009 & toilet trained.

Enrollment: 14 children with one teacher and one parent helper

9:15 a.m.-11:45 a.m.

Tuition: \$1212.00 per year (\$404.00 x three payments)

9:15 a.m.-1:00 p.m.

Tuition: \$1887.00 per year (\$629.00 x three payments)

Additional Financial Obligations

Registration Fee: \$50 non-refundable

Yearly Supply Fee: \$35 due with first tuition payment

Fundraising: Participation is required *per enrolled student* for our Spring Fundraiser - \$100 minimum sales or option of a buyout

Tuition payments are due July 1st, November 1st & March 1st

Parental Obligations – We are a cooperative preschool that relies on the participation of every enrolled family in order to run smoothly and effectively.

Parent Helper

Approximately one day per month *per enrolled child* – frequency may vary based on class size.

Parent helper will bring a small nutritious snack and drink for the class and assist the teacher throughout the day. The day you are the parent helper, your child is the “line leader,” gives the weather report, and does calendar duties during circle time.

Committee Positions

Each family must hold one committee position *per enrolled child* or serve as a board member. Some examples of committees are Fundraising, Health/State Inspection, Field Trip Planning, Bulletin Board, Special Events/Social, and Upkeep/Cleaning.

Parent Meetings

Parents must attend the mandatory parent meetings held in May & August.

Program Description

- Follows guidelines set by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC)
- Licensed by the State of Ohio Department of Jobs & Family Services
- Classrooms include areas for fine motor skills to be exercised through daily crafts, painting, play dough, and other manipulatives. Role playing areas rotate between a grocery store, post office, housekeeping, vet center, etc. There is both structured & unstructured play in various learning centers, including a science center, water/bean table, listening center and reading center. The children also have daily story time.
- There is also a large activity room where music and large motor skills are developed using climbing toys, floor games, parachute and the balance beam. The children also play on the playground when weather permits.
- The Extended Day Program includes rotating lessons involving cooking, science, art and Spanish; free play; and lunch. Children enrolled in extended day must bring their own packed lunch.
